Respect means to "look back at" and to "regard" something. These respect agreements are set up to allow us to look back at how we may feel or to have regard for something that arrives.








Self-Care











Play Theory

"We play because we are human, and we need to understand what makes us human, not in an evolutionary or cognitive way but in a humanistic way. Play is the force that pulls us together. It is a way of explaining the world, others, and ourselves. Play is expressing ourselves—who we want to be, or who we don't want to be. Play is what we do when we are human" (Sicart, 2014, p. 6).










Play is...
